## Documents Required To Join Malaysia My Second Home Program

1. **Original Company Letter** stating position, salary (minimum of RM40,000) and date of commencement, with company rubber stamp
2. **Latest 3 months' original proof of income documents of a minimum RM40,000 income monthly**
  - Salary – Salary slips/vouchers with company rubber stamp
  - Pension – Pension Certification Letter/ Pension Certificate
  - Rental income – Latest valid Rental Agreement and Proof of Property Ownership documents
3. **Latest 3 months' original Bank Statements to proof income bank in**
4. **Latest 3 months' original Bank Statements (Saving Account/ Fixed Deposit Certificates) in personal name (or joint as husband/ wife) with bank rubber stamp and name card showing minimum RM 1.5 million**
  - Fixed Deposits with a valid maturity term of not less than 6 months is only acceptable
5. **'Letter of Good Conduct or Police Clearance'** from the relevant government authorities (Police Department, Security Authorities or Embassy in origin country or domicile country)
  - Required for main applicant and spouse (if any)
6. **FULL SET** copy (every page) of the **current passports of all participants (\*)**
  - Information particulars page and all observation pages must be provided. Passport must have minimum 12 months validity. If less than, previous passport is required
7. **1 piece passport size photo (3.5cm x 5.0cm), light blue background) of each applicant**
8. Photocopy of **Marriage Certificate** (if spouse would like to join) (\*)
9. Photocopy of **Children's Birth Certificate** - aged below 21 (if included in the application) (\*)
10. **Resume/Bio-data/Curriculum Vitae**, briefly stating business/work experiences in the last 10 years. (Please include photocopy of Education Certificates, professional license, etc if available)
11. Latest **medical assessment** from residence/ home country by GP doctor for each applicant (form will be provided)
12. **Other supporting documents: Properties Ownership / Children education in Malaysia** (if any) (\*)

(\*) – To be certified by Embassy/ High Commission/ Government Official ONLY.

Where original documents are not in English, translation must be done by a qualified translator from the original country and certified and stamped by Embassy/ High Commission/ Government Official only.
